

Enduro Rules

Eligible Vehicles



Any front or rear wheel drive, 4 Cylinder or 6 Cylinder car or mini van including model years 1977 to 2015, inclusive.

No high performance, Turbo or Supercharged models. If in doubt email us.

All carpeting must be removed from the vehicle prior to arrival at the speedway

All glass including side mirrors and excepting the windshield must be removed entirely

All body panels must remain on the vehicle. No curring or changing the body or suspension.

Exhaust must exit from under the vehicle.

Any DOT approved tire on stock rims for the vehicle allowed. Must all be the same size.

Doors securely welded, bolted, or tied shut (with seatbelt grade strapping)

Must have a minimum 3 point passenger style seat belt. Upgrade to a 4 or 5 point recommended

May replace OEM hood / trunk latch with hood / trunk pins but not required

Battery must be securely fastened down and covered (if inside the vehicle)

All components must be stock for the make mode and year. Original VIN must be visible

Roll Cage is not required for cars with a 5 star rollover rating. All others must have a H style (min) roll cage mounted or “sandwich plated” to the frame and installed just behind the drivers seat for additional seat / seatbelt support. A horizontal bar is required between the two H uprights at dash height

Must have a min 3/8” thick steel plate x 18” inches (or more) in height welded or bolted securely to the body on the drivers side so that half the plate is above the bumper and half is below.

Driver must be able to easily exit the car through the drivers window, under any circumstances

Fire retardant gloves and socks (100% cotton) are required. A DOT or SNELL rated helmet is required

Original rear view mirror is allowed, centered to windshield

Radiator must have WATER ONLY

Numbers must be at least 20 inches high and three inches wide. Larger is better. Must contrast to car color and be on each side of the car on the front doors.

S660, Petty, or Scotia Enduro Rules may also run. No mixing rules. Any violation of any of these rules will result in penalties or disqualification. Tech may require competition adjustments.
